- -Checking results actual vs. budgeted
- -Setting up standards to determine success or failure

-3 types of control

- -1. Preliminary control
 - -Focus on preventing deviation in quality and quantity
 - -E.g. a worker must be qualified before assigned
 - -Its about defining and staffing

-2. Concurrent control

- -Monitoring ongoing operations to ensure objectives are on the track
- -Implemented by supervisors
- -E.g. on the spot inspections by QC

-3. Feedback control

- -Focus on end results
- -Focus on historical outcome as base for correcting future outcome
- -Corrective measurements is taken at this stage

- -Total Quality Management (TQM)
 - -Broad based quality at all levels
 - -TQM is a program dedicated to understand customer values and perception
 - -Its all about customer satisfaction measurement that are linked with corporate measure of quality at all level
