- Setting up standards to determine success or failure
  
- 3 types of control
  - 1. Preliminary control
    - Focus on preventing deviation in quality and quantity
    - E.g. a worker must be qualified before assigned
    - Its about defining and staffing
  - 2. Concurrent control
    - Monitoring ongoing operations to ensure objectives are on the track
    - Implemented by supervisors
    - E.g. on the spot inspections by QC
  - 3. Feedback control
    - Focus on end results
    - Focus on historical outcome as base for correcting future outcome
    - Corrective measurements is taken at this stage

- Total Quality Management (TQM)
  - Broad based quality at all levels
  - TQM is a program dedicated to understand customer values and perception
  - Its all about customer satisfaction measurement that are linked with corporate measure of quality at all level

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
